By Long Island Railroad: From Flatbush Avenue terminal, take the Manhattan-bound 2, 3, 4, from Atlantic Avenue to Borough Hall.

By Car: From Manhattan: Brooklyn Bridge to Cadman Plaza West exit; turn left. Cadman Plaza West becomes Court Street. Turn right on Joralemon Street; right on Clinton Street; right on Remsen Street; From Queens: Brooklyn-Queens Expressway (BQE) to Cadman Plaza exit. Turn right. Follow directions above. Street and metered parking are limited, as well as parking garages.
