April 28 from 7:45-8:45am I got to review the front matter and chapters 1-5 of the plain language translation/adaption of the book Alcoholics Anonymous. An hour was nowhere near enough time to thoroughly read everything in front of me. I was disappointed to say the least, but it was not debatable, so I sat and read.

We had a sharing session on Friday? which allowed anyone who wanted to share the opportunity, and the session was recorded for the writer to listen to after we were done. As soon as the session opened the 10-15 people ran to each of the three the microphones. As I waited for the lines to thin a bit before joining, I listened and jotted down their comments.

What I would like to do now is let you hear the feedback from the other members of the conference. I did not go to the mike as planned since it was suggested that if you already heard what you wanted to say please refrain from going to the microphone. I think they said all I wanted to say and more. Please listen carefully as the comments are in the order that they went to the microphone:

Cara- I came in at 16 knew how to read and comprehend but didn't connect with the Big Book. A sponsor helped me. Reading through this plain language bought me back to when I was 16 and I wish this book was around then for me to read.

Area 38- Bobb asked for a plain language right after the big book was written. Intent was there.

Area 89- Liked the tone- chapter to wives outdated?

Area 9-Facinating- easy read- direct steps 9side by side0

Area 93 greatest accessibility tool- likes style- I can almost hear people quoting passages- I will keep both (subtle Ocontext)

Area 92 – was suspicious- started to feel language of the heart- will go back and set people straight.

Area -6 Felt insulted by big book finally now understood what the chapter means "we agnostics" and I am highly educated.

Area 60 didn't love it – definitions- softening of language- "go to the bitter end deep morass" to be doomed to die an alcoholic death or find a way to live a spiritual life is not an easy choice to make

I cried for an hour and a half during the sharing session – voice of sponsor- didn't need interpreter- easy and accessible.

27- liked headers- liked columns- didn't like definitions, i.e., agnostic, atheist

82- area requested floor action- I had internal bias since I have been part of a big book study since 1975 – loved the book

56-evolved as time went on- struck by beauty, best thing AA has done for alcoholics in a long time

73- not a replacement- excited- Dr. Opinion didn't convey the importance bias- emotions connected-maybe someone will experience emotions after reading

85- dinosaurs ion my area- pleasantly surprised- made sense- flowing & easy. Must see finish line-provide tools- not for me but alcoholic who cannot see light at end of tunnel.

GSO staff- CPC perspective- blown away-removing barriers- professionals have obstacles to our program- make it a CPC tool

59-love the language of the original big book after years of studying Dr. Opinion- what it says to newcomer- tool to access the BB didn't realize

GV editor- I was wondering how we were going to pull this off- water behind my eyes the whole time I was reading

GSO staff – read other plain language books published by other companies- forward & preface "if you are ready to start your journey turn the page"

Area 3-scism- in area two camps- focus more on consequences

GSO staff- 40 years in got sober at 15- tone inviting in a gentle way with options to ask questions

Learned how to read in AA- some of the instructions are missing- course of action- backbone of program-people memorize how it works so others don't know they can't read

23 years of working with people who have brain injuries- I have trouble reading myself

?? thank you-my area is scared- just the beginning and worried about changing more

57- Area against PL – I read the book- not the same magic- don't translate steps

Pablo Central LA- Concerned whole book would be changed- very easy to understand.

44-made energy of love- was there a need? Easier softer way

10- Thought I would hate it. Dr. Opinion side by side – effort made for unity

19- not enough time- enjoyed the reading - my area has many conspiracies theorists

35- promised not to change, modify, or extend steps- bury the book in a deep dark hole
