Discuss update report on methods of closing the Big Meetings at the International Convention. The Committee reviewed the survey results and agreed that the data did not reflect an overwhelming desire by the respondents to change the current practice (i.e., the chairs of the Big meetings at the Internationa Conventions have been invited to close in the manner of their choice, with some closing with the Lord's Prayer, some closing with the Serenity Prayer and some closing with the Responsibility Statement.) Calculating the English, French and Spanish responses in total, the committee noted over 50% responded favorably to keeping with the current practice.
